77% of Americans admitted they switched to online activities in 2020 out of convenience.

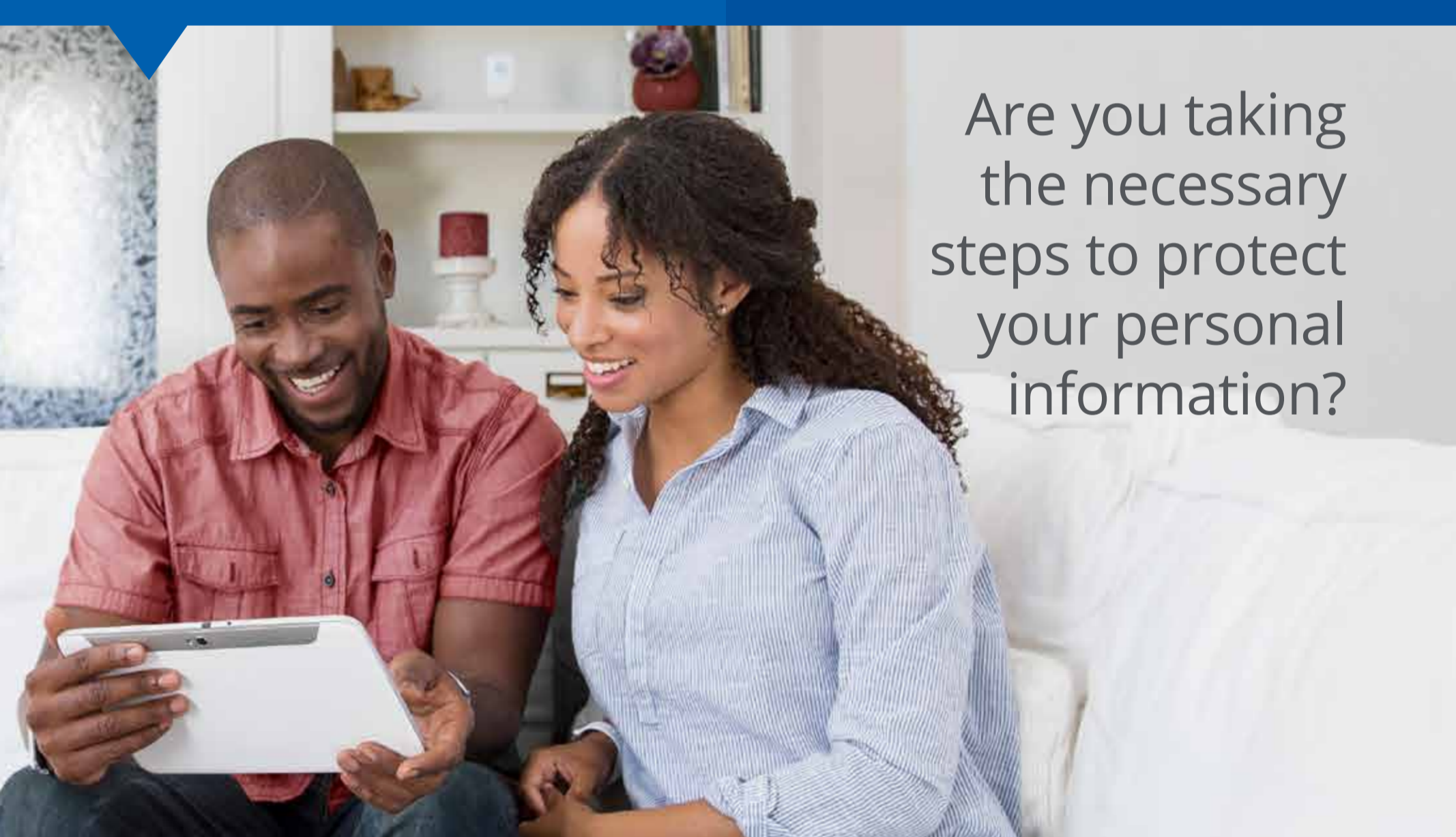


Securely Connected?
